










Bus departures/Arrivals and parking zones

Sector II – Lake CARLIT

- Wild » Brown, Rainbow, Lake, Brook and Dolly Warden Trouts
- Altitude about 2400m
- Hiking 1:30 for the farest beat
- Competition Lakes : Noir, Long, Bailleuil, Dougne, Castella, Trebens and Soubiran



Sector III – River TÊT

- « Wild » Brown & Raimbows Trouts
- Downstream limit : Lake of Vinca at Marquixanes
- Upstream limit : Confluence with the Mentet stream (Upstream Olette)





Sector IV – Lake CAMPORELLS

- « Wild » Brown, Raimbow, Lake, Brook and Dolly Warden Trouts
- Altitude about 2400m
- Hiking 45 mn for the upper lake
- Competition Lakes : All of the 5 lakes of the Comporells site



Sector I – River VICDESSOS

- Wild » Brown & Rainbow Trouts
- Downstream limit : Confluence _ with Ariege river at Tarascon
- Upstream limit : Bridge of the Cascade of Auzat (Above Auzat)

- « Wild » Brown, Rainbow, Trouts and Graylings
- 1:50mn Dedicated to « Woman fly fishing »
- Downstream limit : Bridge at Leclerc supermarket downstream Limoux

« River » Sessions

- ightarrow 44 Beats of 350m in average
- ightarrow 2 sub-sessions of 2h duration
 - 1st sub-session on the 22 beats (1-22)* of the lower river
 - 2nd sub-session on the 22 beats (23-44)* of the upper river

IMPORTANT

« River » Session, the second beat is not fished

 \rightarrow 1 hour of rotation (*with controller's car*)

« Lake » Sessions

- → 22 Beats of 150m in average dispatched on several lakes (5/6 lakes)
- ightarrow 4 sub-sessions of 1h duration on 4 different lakes
- → 45 Minutes of rotation (under controller's guidance)



<u>River Session Time Line – Sector I – River VICDESSOS</u>








Lake Session Time Line – Sector II - Lakes of CARLIT





Competitors & Controllers dispatch to the next Beat



<u>River Session Time Line – Sector III - River TÊT</u>








Lake Session Time Line – Sector IV - Lakes of CAMPORELLS



River Session Time Line – Sector V - River AUDE










Rendez-Vous with your controller

- On « River » sectors, Bring your fishing gears to his car



- That may affect negatively the results on each of the session.



« River » Sessions Rules & Recommendations


- FIPS Rules apply
- BANK Fishing only
 - ightarrow Deliberately swimming or floating is forbidden
 - \rightarrow Feets shall aways be in contact with the river's bottom
- NO SCRAPING !
- MANDATORY Use of Tippet collector (or equivalent)
- Felt Sole are authorized but not recommended

Controller's recommendations

- ightarrow Be fairplay and equitable
- ightarrow Keep closed to your competitor (e.g. 10-15m) and in visual contact with him
- → Stay back to the bank to avoid alarm fishes
- → Be reactive when required (e.g. fish checking / measure)
- → Be vigilant with competitor behavior (e.g. no hand into the net, no touch of fish without your authorization, ...)
- \rightarrow Keep no authorized persons (e.g. Visitors) at a safe and reasonnable distance from the beat
- ightarrow Report any incidents/critical situation to your Sector judge

« Lake » Sessions Rules & Recommendations

- FIPS Rules apply
- BANK Fishing only
 - ightarrow No foot shall touch / enter into the water
 - → Fishing from island / isolated rock is allowed if accessible without touching/entering into the water
- No fishing in the tributaries
- MANDATORY Use of Tippet collector (or equivalent)



Controller's recommendations

- → Be fairplay and equitable
- ightarrow Keep closed to your competitor (e.g. 10-15m) and in visual contact with him
- → Stay back to the bank to avoid alarm fishes
- → Be reactive when required (e.g. fish checking / measure)
- → Be vigilant with competitor behavior (e.g. no hand into the net, no touch of fish without your authorization, no scraping ...)
- \rightarrow Keep no authorized persons (e.g. Visitors) at a safe and reasonnable distance from the beat
- ightarrow Report any incidents/critical situation to your Sector judge
