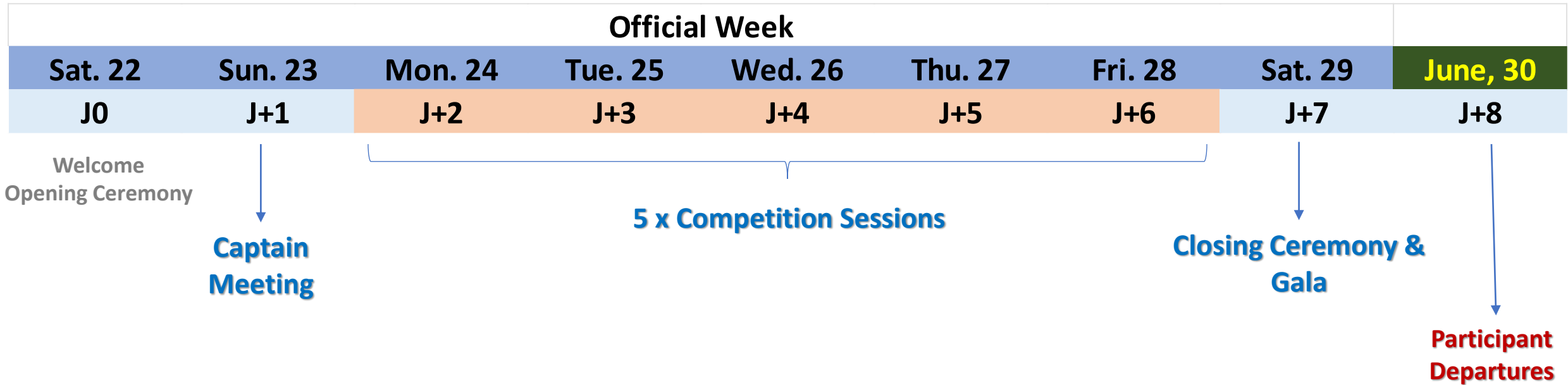

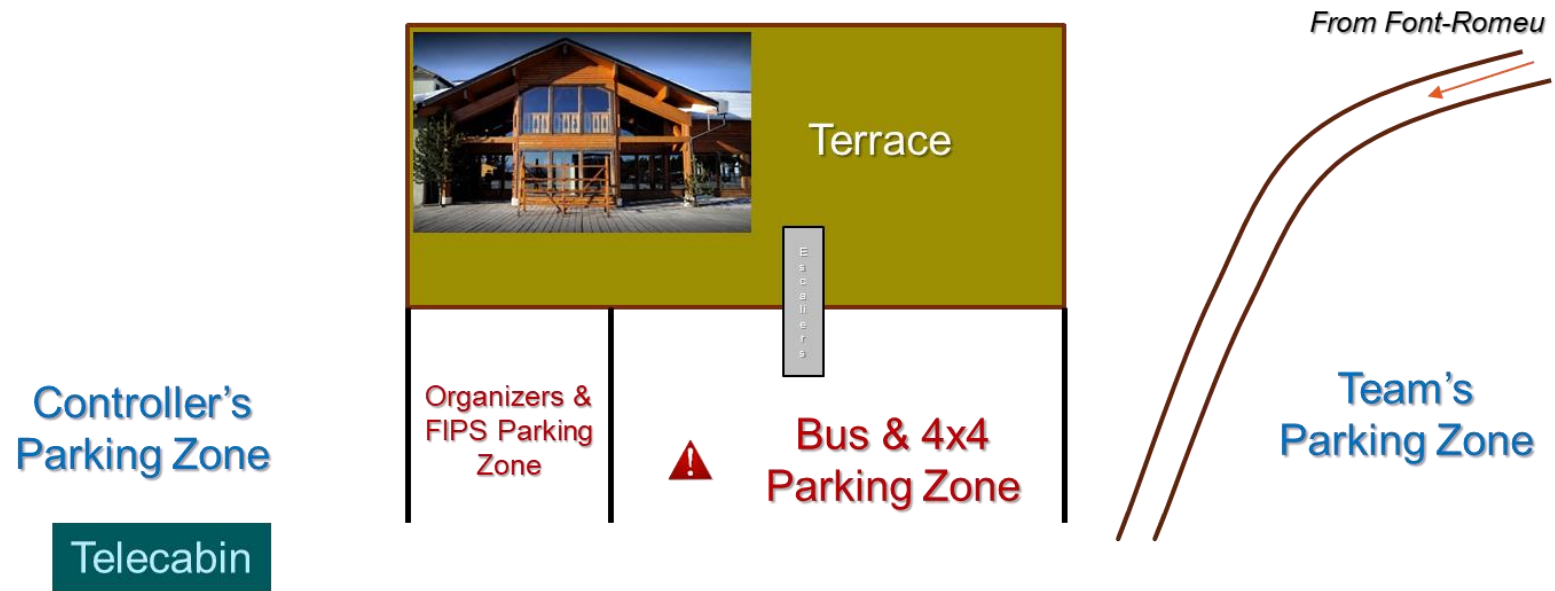

- Upstream limit : Confluence with the Mentet stream (Upstream Olette)



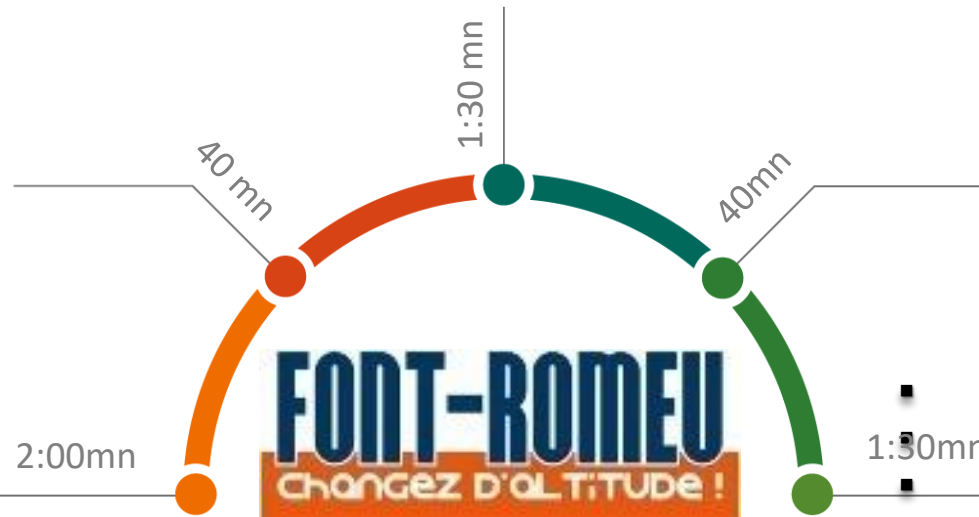
## Sector IV – Lake CAMPORELLS

- Downstream limit : Confluence with Ariège river at Tarascon
- Upstream limit : Bridge of the Cascade of Auzat (Above Auzat)



## Sector V – River AUDE

- « Wild » Brown, Rainbow, Trouts and Graylings
- Dedicated to « Woman fly fishing »
- Downstream limit : Bridge at Leclerc supermarket downstream Limoux
- Upstream limit : Beginning of the Gorges of the Pierre Lys (upstream Belviane)

## « River » Sessions

- 44 Beats of 350m in average
- 2 sub-sessions of 2h duration
  - 1<sup>st</sup> sub-session on the 22 beats (1-22)\* of the lower river
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> sub-session on the 22 beats (23-44)\* of the upper river

### **IMPORTANT**

**« River » Session, the second beat is not fished**

- 1 hour of rotation (*with controller's car*)

## « Lake » Sessions

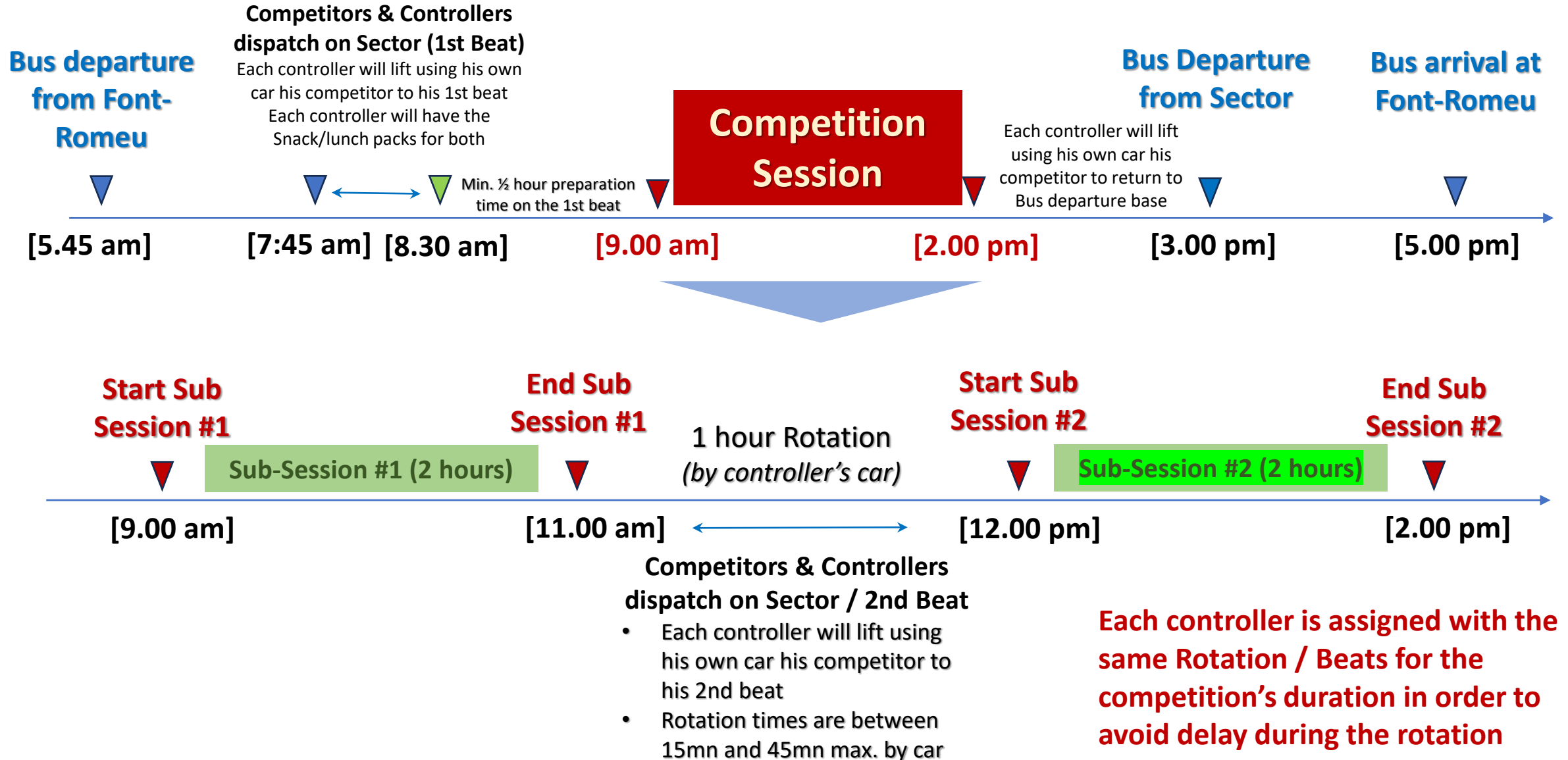
- 22 Beats of 150m in average dispatched on several lakes (5/6 lakes)
- 4 sub-sessions of 1h duration on 4 different lakes
- 45 Minutes of rotation (*under controller's guidance*)

### **\* Sector V - Aude**

- 1<sup>st</sup> sub-session on the 22 beats (23-44) of the upper river
- 2<sup>nd</sup> sub-session on the 22 beats (1-22) of the lower river

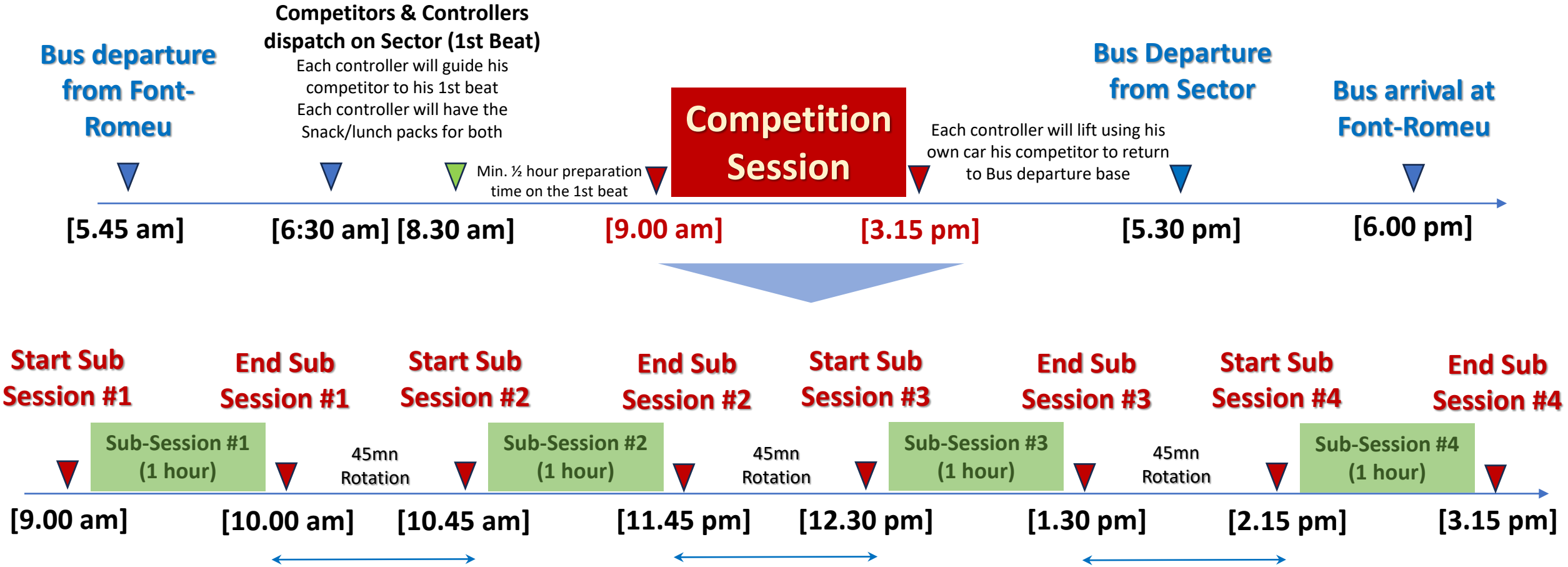

Size Limit sets to **20cm** for all eligible species

# « River » Sessions Rules & Recommendations



- **FIPS Rules apply**
- **BANK Fishing only**
  - Deliberately swimming or floating is forbidden
  - Feet shall always be in contact with the river's bottom
- **NO SCRAPING !**
- **MANDATORY Use of Tippet collector (or equivalent)**
- **Felt Sole are authorized but not recommended**







- **Controller's recommendations**

- Be fairplay and equitable
- Keep closed to your competitor (e.g. 10-15m) and in visual contact with him
- Stay back to the bank to avoid alarm fishes
- Be reactive when required (e.g. fish checking / measure)
- Be vigilant with competitor behavior (e.g. no hand into the net, no touch of fish without your authorization, ...)
- Keep no authorized persons (e.g. Visitors) at a safe and reasonable distance from the beat
- Report any incidents/critical situation to your Sector judge

## Stand for Waders / Boot Disinfection

### DISINFECTION PROTOCOL FOR WADERS

-  Vibram soles are preferable to felt soles.
-  Rinse your waders in water, removing as many fragments as possible.
-  Dip your shoes in the basin with the disinfectant and rub the soles.  
Rub your waders with the product for a few moments.  
Avoid contact with your hands.
-  Leave the product to dry without rinsing for at least 1 hour.





# « Lake » Sessions Rules & Recommendations



- **FIPS Rules apply**
- **BANK Fishing only**
  - **No foot shall touch / enter into the water**
  - Fishing from island / isolated rock is allowed if accessible without touching/entering into the water
- **No fishing in the tributaries**
- **MANDATORY Use of Tippet collector (or equivalent)**

- Keep no authorized persons (e.g. Visitors) at a safe and reasonable distance from the beat
- Report any incidents/critical situation to your Sector judge
