On river Tet only brown trout is eligible due to a release of rainbow from hatchery at only a couple of beats. Maintaining rainbow trout as eligible would lead to unfair competition.

It was unanimously decided that on the lakes all salmonids are eligible (brown trout, rainbow trout, brook trout, dolly warden, lake trout)
